## Camp LeJeune Water Poisoning Claims

### New Claims Available for Camp Lejeune Marines and Others Poisoned by Toxic Water

If you or anyone you know drank water at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune in North Carolina between August 1953 and December 1987, that water was contaminated with toxic chemicals that may have caused or may still cause cancers or other illnesses.

Fortunately, [the government has made it possible to seek compensation if you file a claim with the Navy by August 9, 2024 and then file a lawsuit under the Camp Lejeune Justice Act.](#) Lawsuits alleging veterans and their families were poisoned by contaminated water at Camp Lejeune are progressing quickly in North Carolina federal court, with Elizabeth Cabraser of Lieff Cabraser serving as one of the court-appointed Co-Lead Counsel for Plaintiffs.

Anyone who drank the contaminated water can file a claim—whether you are a **veteran who served on base**, a **family member who lived on base**, a **civilian who worked on base**, or the **relative of a loved one who died** after drinking water on base. **A Camp Lejeune Justice Act claim will not affect your VA benefits.**

Although you can file a claim for any illness related to contaminated water at Camp Lejeune, the government has identified certain illnesses it admits can be caused by this exposure, including kidney cancer, non-Hodgkin's lymphoma, leukemia, liver cancer, bladder cancer, multiple myeloma, Parkinson's disease, end-stage renal (kidney) disease, systemic sclerosis or scleroderma, and cardiac birth defects.

**We recommend you contact an attorney to help you file your claim with the Navy and your subsequent lawsuit.** The information you provide the Navy may limit what you can seek in a lawsuit.

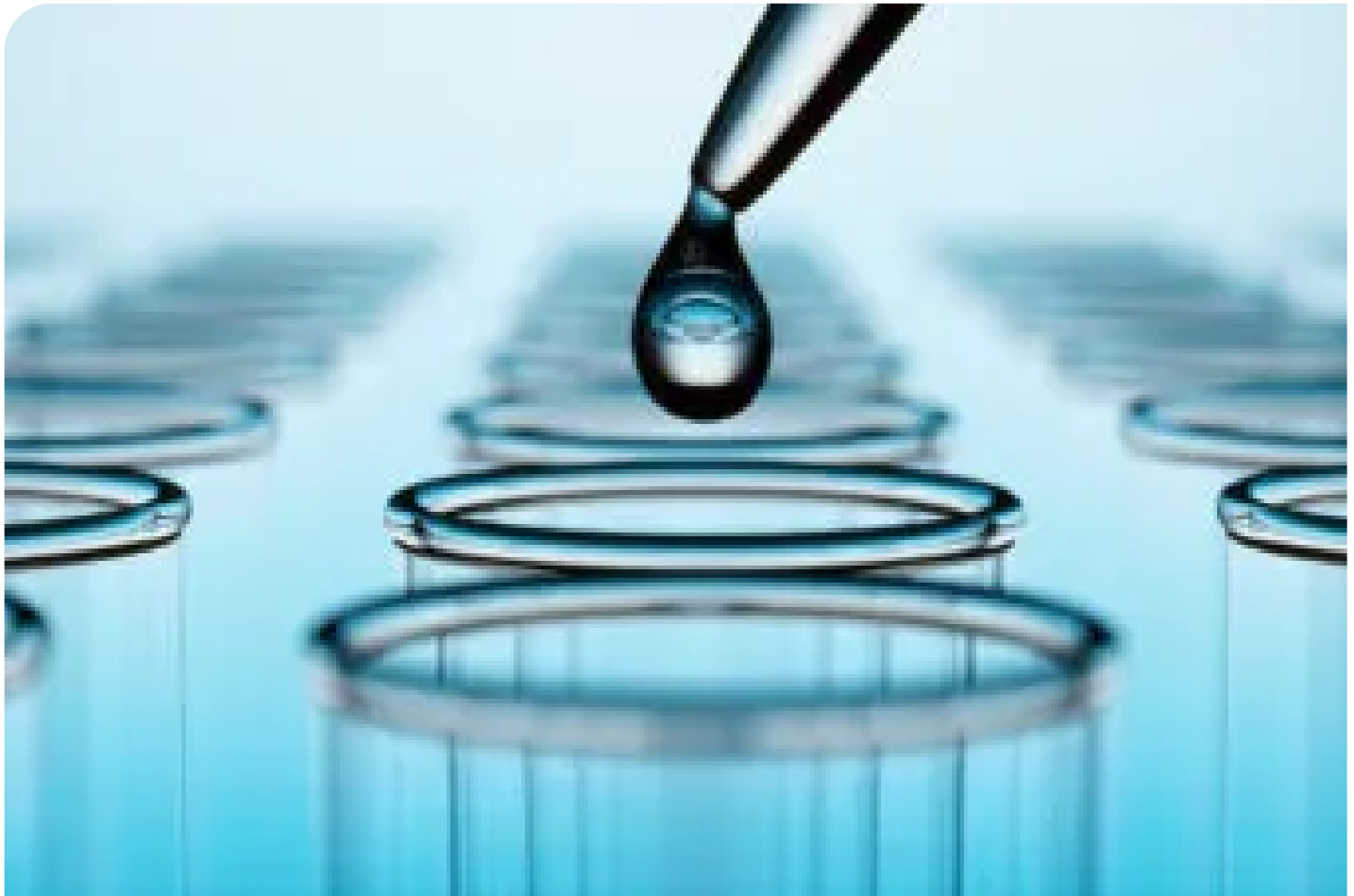

# Camp Lejeune Deadline

## ACTIVE CASE

Thanks to the Camp Lejeune Justice Act, service members and their family members as well as civilians who were exposed to Camp Lejeune toxic water can seek compensation for their injuries. The deadline is in **August 2024**.

## When is the Camp Lejeune Claim deadline?

The Camp Lejeune deadline is **August 9, 2024**. People interested in holding the government accountable for the toxic drinking water at Camp Lejeune must submit their claim with the Department of the Navy by this date.

Failure to do so **will bar any future attempts at compensation**.

## Why is there a Camp Lejeune lawsuit deadline?

Government studies estimate that between August 1953 and December 1987, service members, civilian contractors and family living at U.S. Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, may have been exposed to contaminated drinking water. While a claim against the government would typically be outside the statute of limitations, such claims are permitted by the [Camp Lejeune Justice Act \(CLJA\)](#), which opened up claims against the government for two years.

The CLJA, as part of the [Honoring our PACT Act](#), was passed by Congress and signed into law by President Biden in August 2022.

This means that people interested in pursuing justice from the government for health issues they developed from the contaminated drinking water at Camp Lejeune have until **August 9, 2024**, to file an administrative claim with the Department of the Navy.

---

## How can someone file a Camp Lejeune claim before the deadline?

Eligible people or their legally authorized representatives must start by filing an administrative claim with the Department of the Navy (DON) before the deadline set by the Camp Lejeune Justice Act.

Lawsuits for claims may not be filed right away. Instead, a lawsuit may be filed in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina if:

- The administrative claim is denied.
- The Navy fails to issue a final decision within six months of the claim being filed.
- The claimant rejects the [government's inadequate offer of relief](#).

If a claim is denied, **the deadline for filing a Camp Lejeune lawsuit is 180 days** from the date of denial.

## Who is eligible for a Camp Lejeune claim?

The Camp Lejeune Justice Act requires the following conditions for a person to be eligible to file a claim for themselves or as a legally authorized representative:

- **Residency:** Lived, worked, or were in utero at Camp Lejeune for at least 30 days, which need not be consecutive.
- **Timing:** Fulfilled Residency between August 1, 1953, and December 31, 1987.
- **Harm:** Experienced a harm that can be linked to toxic drinking water at Camp Lejeune.

The CLJA requires that claimants provide sufficient evidence linking their condition to their toxic exposure. For more information about what qualifies as evidence or for help with the claims process, consider contacting a [Camp Lejeune lawyer](#).

## WHAT CONDITIONS MAY BE LINKED TO CAMP LEJEUNE?

Other health conditions may be eligible for financial compensation from the federal government. However, it will be up to the individual to demonstrate the connection between the condition and the toxic exposure at Camp Lejeune.

## Is there a settlement deadline for Camp Lejeune claims?

Under the CLJA, there isn't a mandated Camp Lejeune deadline for settlements. Instead, the only deadlines are for claimants to:

- File their claims by **August 9, 2024**
- File a lawsuit **within 180 days of a claim denial.**

As of February 2024, more than 160,000 claimants have filed for Camp Lejeune claims. Fewer than 100 people have been offered a settlement from the government, with fewer than 20 accepting the offer.

---

## Be aware of Camp Lejeune scams as the deadline approaches

In January 2024, the Department of Navy and the Department of Justice issued a warning about fraud relating to Camp Lejeune claims and lawsuits. They warned that potential or current claimants may be targeted for money or personal information. The Justice Department advises that individuals reach out to their attorneys or the Navy's Camp Lejeune Claims Unit if they are concerned about a potential scam.

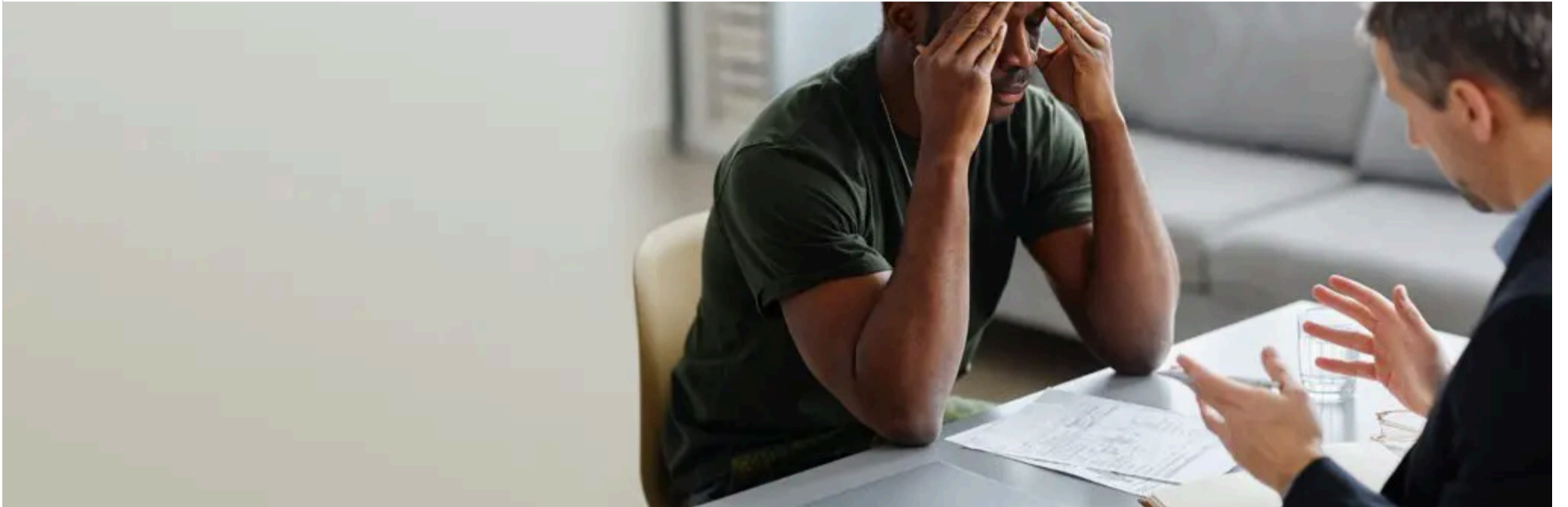

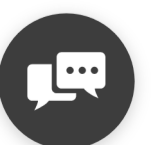

## You Have Limited Time to Act

The Honoring Our PACT Act of 2022 (**S.3373**), which includes the Camp Lejeune Justice Act was signed into law on August 10, 2022.

**Under this law, those affected by water contamination at Camp Lejeune have only two years from when the statute was enacted to file a lawsuit.**



## Who Qualifies for a Camp Lejeune Water Contamination Lawsuit?

Under the Camp Lejeune Justice Act, military personnel, family members, and employees working on the base are permitted to file civil lawsuits against the U.S. Government for harm sustained during at least

thirty days of exposure to water at Camp Lejeune between August 1, 1953 and December 31, 1987. This includes in utero exposure.

If you served, worked, or lived at Camp Lejeune from the 1950s to the 1980s, you may have been exposed to toxins in contaminated drinking water. You may qualify for a legal claim or lawsuit if you can show that:

- You were stationed at Camp Lejeune
- You were a veteran, civilian worker, or resident (or a family member of one)
- You served between August 1953 and December 1987
- You served for at least 30 days
- You were on active duty
- You were not discharged dishonorably
- You have a qualifying health condition

It is estimated that more than **one million people may have been affected by the water contamination at Camp Lejeune** over the course of roughly three decades. This includes members of the military, civilian employees on the base, and families – including children and babies in utero.

## What Health Conditions Are Linked to Toxic Exposure at Camp Lejeune?

In 1982, the Marine Corps discovered volatile organic compounds

(VOCs) in the drinking water provided by two of the eight water

treatment plants on the Camp Lejeune base: Hadnot Point Treatment Plant and Tarawa Terrace Treatment Plant. Testing at these plants found benzene, vinyl chloride (VC), trichloroethylene (TCE), and tetrachloroethylene or perchloroethylene (PCE).

The Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) reports that supply wells were contaminated by multiple sources: **waste disposal sites, industrial area spills, and leaking underground storage tanks**. The most contaminated wells were reportedly closed in 1985.

The toxic chemical compounds found in the base's drinking water have been linked to various types of cancer and other serious health conditions.

# Can I File a Personal Injury Lawsuit?

Until recently, individuals who served, lived, or worked at Camp Lejeune for at least 30 days between August 1, 1953, and December 31, 1987 have been barred from filing a lawsuit for toxic exposure due to North Carolina's **10-year statute of repose**. Under this statute of repose, the time limit for filing a lawsuit starts at the time of the last exposure, instead of when the causation was discovered.

Because most victims did not discover that their illnesses were caused by contaminated water at Camp Lejeune until more than a decade after the exposure, they were prohibited from claiming the compensation they deserve. This obstacle was upheld by the Supreme Court. Overcoming it required an act of Congress.

Signed into law on August 10, 2022, the Camp Lejeune Justice Act allows victims of toxic exposure at Camp Lejeune to bypass North Carolina's statute of repose and file civil lawsuits against the U.S. government for damages.

If you or your family members suffered losses due to toxic exposure at Camp Lejeune, you may be able to pursue compensation for:

- Medical expenses
- Lost wages
- Diminished earning capacity
- Emotional distress
- Pain and suffering
- Disability
- Loss of companionship and society
- Out-of-pocket expenses

**If you or a family member previously received health and disability benefits for an illness related to water contamination at Camp Lejeune, your compensation will be reduced in proportion to any prior payments or awards.**

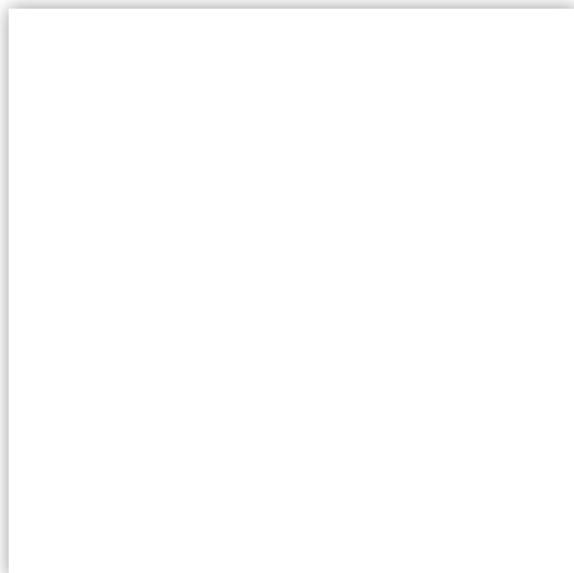

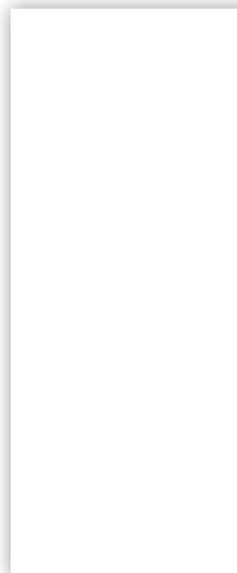

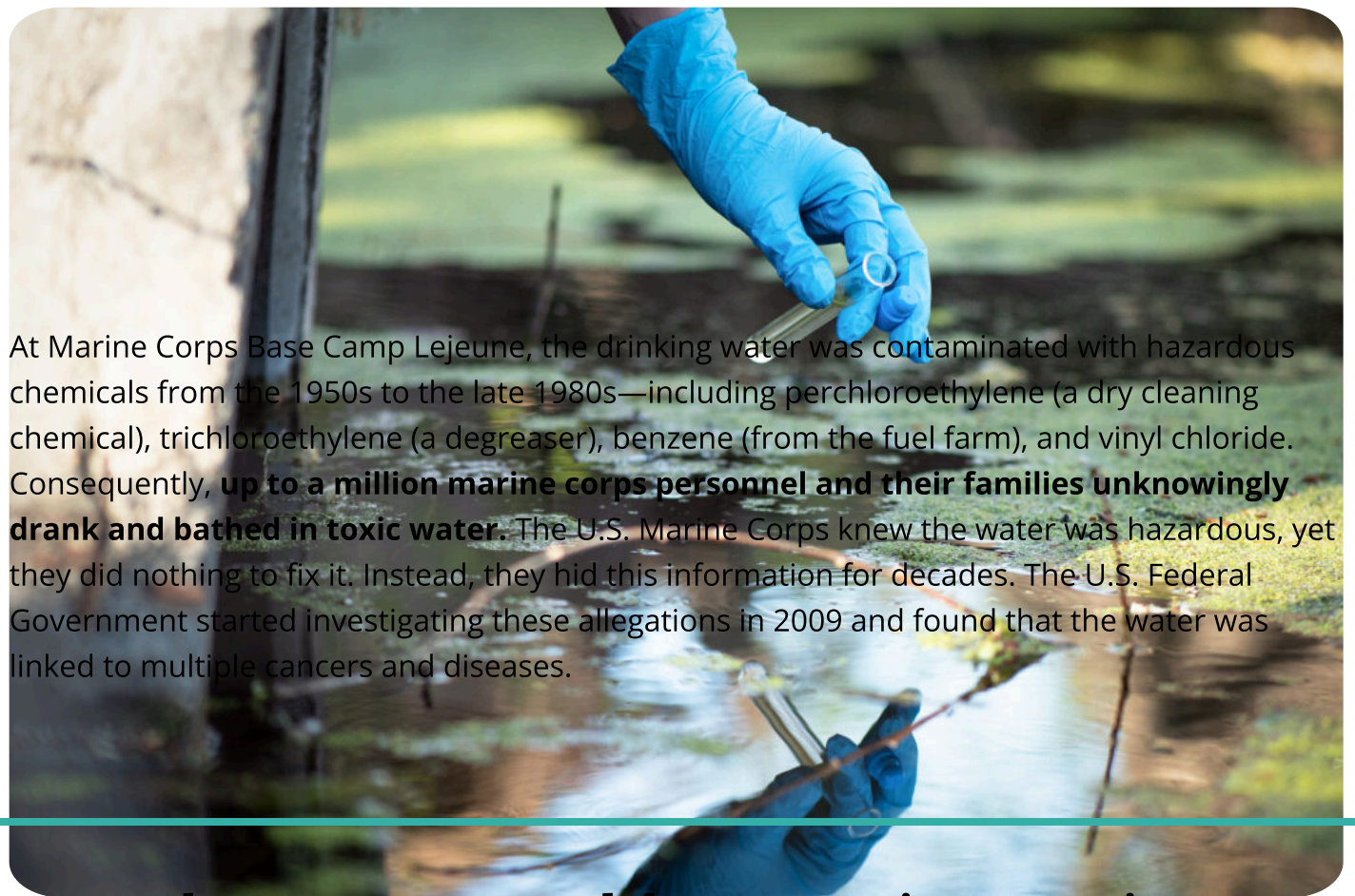
